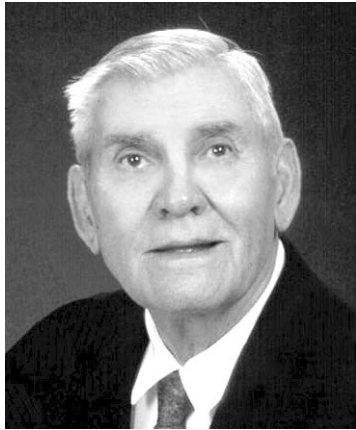


ROBERT L. "BOB" GOODE



Robert L. "Bob" Goode, 80, former owner of Dyna Mud Corporation and Dynamic Drilling, died June 9, 2007 in Fort Worth.

Mr. Goode was born June 5, 1927 to Jennings and Helen Goode in Roby. He married Sylvia Killingsworth April 8, 1950 in Houston.

While playing football at Texas A&M, Bob set several Southwest Conference rushing records and played in two college All-Star East-West Bowl games. From 1949 to 1955, as a first round draft pick, he played running back for the Washington Redskins NFL football team, as well as playing in two Pro Bowl games.

As a 32nd-degree Mason, he was a member of the Bridgeport Masonic Lodge. He was U.S. Marine Corp. Veteran serving in Korea, a member of the Roughneck Club and First United Methodist Church of Bridgeport.

Survivors include his loving wife of 57 years, Sylvia; son, Robert L. Goode Jr. and his wife, Vicki; daughter, Susie Monzingo and her husband, Marc, all of Fort Worth; grandsons, Bobby and Danny Goode; aunt, Merie Lovett of Rotan; and a host of friends.

Funeral service is Wednesday, June 13 at 10:30 a.m. at the First United Methodist Church in Bridgeport with the Reverends Mike Miller and Johnny Irish officiating. Interment is at the East Burial Cemetery. Honorary pallbearers are W. E. Smith, M.L. Man-oushagin, R. N. Walker, Carlos Mann, G.E. Taylor, H. F. Meyers and Rollins Bilby.
