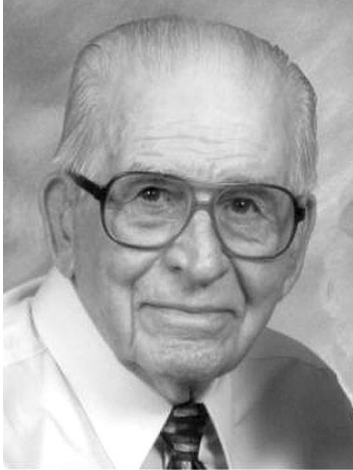


MARSHALL F. JOHNSON
