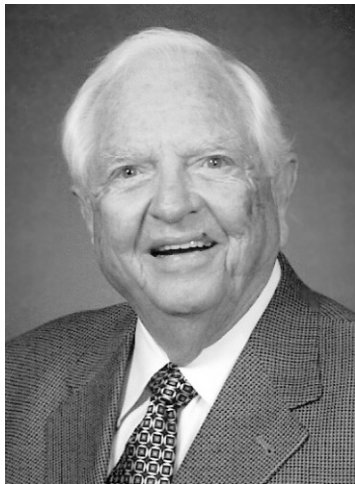


MILTON LOWRY MANOUSHAGIAN
